### **What are cookies?**

A cookie is a file that is stored on your computer system (computer, smartphone, tablet, etc.) when you visit certain websites. Cookies allow a website to, among other things, store and recover information about the browsing habits of a user or their computer and, depending on the information they contain and the way the system is used, can be used to identify the user.

### **What types of cookies does the arText system website use?**

Our website only uses performance cookies, that is, those that allow us to count the number of users and, therefore, measure and statistically analyze the use users make of our website. We therefore analyze your browsing habits on our website in order to improve our project.

### **How can I deactivate or remove cookies from my computer system?**
